Adelaide to host Rescue 2012, the Lifesaving **World Championships**

Adelaide is set to host Rescue 2012, the Lifesaving World Championships in November 2012, with competitors from over 40 nations taking

Held every two years and running over a two week period, the blockbuster event for lifesavers from across the globe will commence on November 4, running through to Sunday November 18.

Rescue 2012 features five separate competitions within nine disciplines, and is open to all proficient lifesavers (including Masters – 30 years and above). Surf Life Saving Australia (SLSA) together with International Life Saving Federation (ILS) will deliver the event, thanks to the support of the South Australian Government.

Adelaide will provide an ideal setting for the event, which will be held over three different locations: Glenelg, Christies Beach and the new Adelaide State Aquatic Centre at Marion.

- Glenelg Beach will host the Beach, National Teams and al IRB events
- Christies Beach will be the home of all Masters, Interclub and Surf Boat events The Adelaide State Aquatic Centre will host all Rescue 2012 Pool events

Accommodation

Decided to make your way to Adelaide for Rescue 2012? Perhaps it's time to start thinking about accommodation. There is a wide variety of accommodation options available throughout Adelaide, from Glenelg and the CBD, all the way to Christie's Beach, approximately 25 minutes from Glenelg Beach.

Accommodation ranges from low budget options including caravan parks and motels, through to five-star hotels and property rentals.



Rescue 2012 has placed reserved bookings on a large number of accommodation options across Adelaide at a fixed rate. This means that should you book now or in July 2012, the cost of accommodation will not vary. Reserved bookings on accommodation will be released three months prior to the event, so we encourage you to book early and not miss out on these fixed rates or miss out all together!

At the conclusion of each e-newsletter, we will take the opportunity to leave you with a Coaching Tip.

- Know the venues Adelaide, South Australia (Pool & Ocean)
- Google Earth & Maps to know exactly where you are located and the distances from each other as well as your accommodation.
- Weather and general climate for November (end of Spring / start of Summer). Water temperature, daily minimum and maximum temperatures.
- Know the specifics of the Pool (indoor / outdoor, depths, contours, type of blocks, warm up pool available, walls, type of bottom etc)
- Does your team need a separate room for recovery or general get-a-way need the pool if staying some distance away?
