COMPETITION RULES

Participation and classifications

- The competitions for athletes of 14 and younger are in principle for Belgian and Dutch participants.
- For the age groups A-B-M (BeNe Cup) each club/federation can enter one team (open category) consisting of athletes that also take part in the individual events. There is a maximum of 6 male and 6 female athletes for such a team. Clubs/federations can enter as many individual athletes as they want. Only individual participants that also take part in relays count for the BeNe Cup classifications.
- Participants that swim for clubteams can also count for National teams. Names have to be specified before the start of the competitions.
- Athletes can enter in all 6 individual events.
- The entry fee for the **BeNe Cup** is 10 Euros per participant.
- BeNe Cup classifications:
 - Each athlete gains points for each events according to LEN tables;
 - For an individual competitor the points scored on the best 4 events will count for the overall individual results. The 3 best per category (A-B-M) (male and female) receive medals;
 - For the team results (BeNe Cup) the scores of the best 4 athletes (on 4 events) and the relay results add up.
 - There are **BeNe-Cups** for the best 3 male and female club teams and two exchange trophies for the best female and male national team.
- Per events there will be certificates for the 3 best results.
- Final entries by 10 November 2013.
- Both organizing federations will make their own results for their National champions per category.
- **Competition rule book is ILS Rule Book 2013.** (Special attention for manikin carry and distance line throw)
- A competitor who withdraws from an event during the competitions cannot start in any event after that.
- We expect a great number of competitors at this competition. Changing of entries (add competitors or changing of events) is not possible after 10 November!!!
- Competitors have to use the manikins and rescue tubes supplied by the organizing committee. Bring your own fins.
- For the A-B-M events we will use electronic timing.
- Competitors must use the steps at the pool side to leave the pool!!!
- This is an official ILS Sanctioned Event, so official records can be made.

EXTRA INFORMATION

DOPING CONTROL

Competitors in categories A, B and M can be selected for doping control. This will be organized by the doping authority. They will select the competitors for this doping control. A competitor in these categories cannot refuse the doping control. We will apply for doping control when a competitor swims an official European or World Record. A competitor should be WADA registered to apply for a European or World record.
